EXPECT DELAYS: I-95 Nighttime Traffic

Paces July 7

Georgia DOT wants motorists to be aware of north and south bound traffic paces on Interstate 95 scheduled Friday, July 7 between 12 a.m. (midnight) and 1 a.m. starting northbound at Exit 3 and southbound at Exit 9 in Camden County. These traffic paces will be utilized for utility work across I-95.

Traffic will be paced 20 mph typically not exceeding 15 minutes. Law Enforcement will be piloting the traffic paces to maximize safety. Motorists should expect delays during paces in this area. All work is weather contingent.
