I-95 Southbound Lane Closure Scheduled Wednesday at Exit 49

WHAT: Georgia DOT wants the traveling public to be aware of the I-95 southbound lane closure Wednesday between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at Exit 49 in McIntosh County. This right lane closure is a necessity for the contractor to lay asphalt on the southbound entrance ramp. All work is weather contingent.

This is a **WORK ZONE** and extreme caution is necessary. Motorists are strongly advised to reduce speeds as they travel through this construction work zone. Message signs, barrels and/or cones will be utilized to alert the public of the upcoming changes.

WHEN: 8 a.m. until 5 p.m., Wednesday, March 23, weather permitting.

WHERE: I-95 Southbound starting at milepost 49.5 to 48.5 at Exit 49 (Darien/SR 251) in McIntosh County.
