SR 99 Lane Closure Required at I-95 Interchange

WHAT: The Georgia Department of Transportation wants the traveling public to be aware of a planned **Thursday, April 2** northbound lane closure on State Route 99 at the I-95 Interchange area. The contractor will shut down one lane to facilitate concrete pouring close to the roadway. A flagging operation will direct motorists. All work is weather contingent.

Motorist should expect delays during this operation and should exercise caution by reducing speed within the work zone. Drivers should be aware that personnel and equipment will be operating in close proximity to travel lanes.

This punch list work is part of the \$11 million interchange reconstruction project in the City of Brunswick. This project includes reconstruct of the SR 99/I-95 interchange in order to raise and lengthen the bridge. Two, 12-foot through lanes, two opposing left turn lanes, a variable raised median and two bike shoulders (one in each direction) are project highlights.

WHEN: Thursday, April 2 from 8 a.m. until 5 p.m., weather permitting

WHERE: SR 99 North at I-95 mile markers 15.5 to 16.5 in Brunswick
