Overnight Ramp Closure from I-20 to I-285 Will Require Detour

WHAT:

Weather permitting; Georgia Department of Transportation contractors will close the **I-20 westbound** ramp to **I-285 southbound** overnight next week. The ramp closure will also require additional lane closures on **I-20 westbound** and **I-285 southbound**. The closures will allow contractors to resurface the ramps. Motorists traveling on I-20 westbound to I-285 southbound must use a detour during the ramp closure.

WHEN:

9 p.m., Monday, June 13 until 5 a.m., Tuesday, June 14
9 p.m., Tuesday, June 14 until 5 a.m., Wednesday, June 15

WHERE:

I-20 westbound ramp to I-285 southbound

One lane will close on **I-285 southbound** between SR 8/ Hollowell Parkway and SR 139/ Martin Luther King Jr. Drive.

One lane will close on **I-20 westbound** between SR 280/ Hamilton E. Homes Drive and the I-285 interchange.

DETOUR:

Motorists traveling on I-20 westbound to I-285 southbound will continue traveling westbound and exit at SR 70/ Fulton Industrial Boulevard. Motorists will continue on SR 70/ Fulton Industrial Boulevard to I-20 eastbound. Motorists can travel on the I-20 eastbound to the I-285 southbound exit.

ADVISORY:

Message boards and detour signs will be in place. Trucks hauling materials will move in and out of the lane closures. Crews and heavy equipment will also be in close proximity to traffic traveling on the interstate.
