Overnight Rolling and Single Lane Closures Planned on SR 400 for the *Transform 285/400* Improvement Project

What: Weather permitting, Georgia Department of Transportation contractors will close lanes on SR 400, both northbound and southbound, for speed limit sign installation, geotechnical investigations, and drainage cleaning and video.

When: Friday, May 5, 8 p.m. through Saturday, May 6, 6 a.m.: A rolling closure will occur in alternating one right lane and one left lanes on SR 400 northbound and southbound from the Glenridge Connector to north of Spalding Drive.

Sunday, May 7 through Friday, May 12, nightly from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m.: One right lane and one left lane will close alternately on SR 400 northbound and southbound from the Glenridge Connector to Hammond Drive.

Advisory: Exact dates may change due to weather or other factors. Motorists are cautioned to reduce their speed while traveling through work zones, pay attention and watch for workers. Before heading out, get real-time information on work status and traffic conditions. Call 511, visit 511ga.org, or download the Georgia 511 app.
