MAKING PROGRESS: A Traffic Shift to Take Place on Old Alabama Road

ATLANTA- Georgia Department of Transportation contractors will shift traffic on Old Alabama Road starting at **8 p.m., Tuesday, August 9**; weather permitting.

Eastbound traffic (traffic traveling toward state Route 141/Medlock Bridge Road) on Old Alabama Road will shift to the newly paved lanes. The single westbound lane (traffic traveling toward Jones Bridge Road) will remain in the current configuration. The current eastbound lanes will close to allow contractors to build a median and move to the third phase of construction.

The project includes widening Old Alabama Road from three lanes to four lanes separated by a 20-foot wide median. A five-foot wide sidewalk will be constructed next to the eastbound lanes and 10-foot multi-use trail will be built adjacent to the westbound lanes. A left turn lane will be added on SR 141/Medlock Bridge Road to Old Alabama Road. The project will accommodate the volume of traffic traveling from SR 141/Medlock Bridge Road to Old Alabama Road.

Message boards are in place to inform motorists about the traffic shift.



Eastbound traffic will soon shift to the new eastbound lanes. Contractors will begin building a median between the lanes.
