## **MOWING ACTIVITIES SCHEDULED FOR COWETA, MERIWETHER and TROUP COUNTIES**

THOMASTON, GA – The Georgia Department of Transportation announces routine maintenance activities planned for this week in Coweta, Meriwether and Troup Counties.

Most activities will only require shoulder or median lane closures. A single lane closure and/or flagman will be utilized for culvert work and bridge deck repair. This is a tentative schedule; if emergency response is needed at a crash scene or if emergency repairs are necessary this schedule can change.

**WHEN:** Daily, Monday, July 29 through Friday, August 2 with work hours 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. as weather permits.

**WHERE:** Coweta

- Mowing along SR 54, SR 41, and SR 14

Meriwether

- Mowing along SR 362 and SR 41

Troup

- Mowing along SR 14 SPUR, SR 14 and SR 54

Motorists should reduce their speed in these and all work zones.

Flagmen may be used for this work. Motorists are asked to use caution, reduce their speed and be alert to changing traffic conditions in work zones.
