Bridge Work for NWC Express Lanes Requires Night Time Detours of I-75 Southbound Ramps at Delk Road

WHAT: Weather permitting, night time detours will take place for bridge construction within the NWC project corridor.

WHEN: Thursday, July 7th during the off-peak hours of 9:00 p.m. to 5:00. a.m.

WHERE:

I-75 Southbound from Delk Road Entrance Ramp Closure – 9:00 p.m. to 2:00 a.m.

Between the off-peak hours of 9:00 p.m. to 2:00 a.m.:
Delk Road Eastbound and Westbound traffic traveling to I-75 Southbound will be directed to travel northbound on Franklin Gateway to South Marietta Parkway. Traffic will then be directed to turn right on South Marietta Parkway followed by another right to enter I-75 Southbound.

I-75 Southbound to Delk Road Exit Ramp Closure – 3:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m.

Between the off peak hours of 3:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m.:
Traffic traveling I-75 Southbound to Delk Road (Exit 261) will be directed exit the interstate at South Marietta Parkway (Exit 263). Traffic will then be directed to turn right on South Marietta Parkway followed by a left on Franklin Gateway to travel south for access to Delk Road.

*Detours will not take place concurrently and the approximate times may shift as the work dictates. Motorists are reminded to pay special attention to law enforcement, traffic control devices, signs and posted speed limits to ensure safe passage through the area.
