New signal debuting Friday in Tennille

TENNILLE— The newly constructed signalized intersection of the relocated state Route (SR) 68 and SR 15 will enter full “stop and go” operation Friday morning.

Currently, traffic on SR 15 doesn’t stop while the realigned SR 68 approach and the Georgia DOT District Office drive operate as a two-way stop. Message boards installed today will alert citizens to the upcoming change.

Citizens can expect to see equipment and personnel paving shoulders, topping the final surface course, applying permanent striping, completing concrete driveways and signage in the coming weeks. Contractors are working now to transform the Old Balls Ferry Road section that’s closed to thru-traffic into a cul-de-sac.

Whenever you approach a work zone: slow down; allow extra distance between vehicles; read signs; obey road crew flaggers; and expect the unexpected.
