New Traffic Signal Activation Scheduled Tomorrow on State Route 21 in Port Wentworth

WHAT: The Georgia Department of Transportation announces a new traffic signal will begin flash mode tomorrow on SR 21 at the intersection of Rice Mill Road/Market Boulevard in Port Wentworth. Message boards will be in place to prepare motorists for this new traffic signal. If weather permits, the signal will be fully operational Wednesday, August 5.

Motorists are reminded to pay special attention to traffic control devices, signs and posted speed limits to ensure safe passage through the new signal location.

WHEN: Flash mode: Tuesday, August 4, weather permitting.
Fully operational: Wednesday, August 5, weather permitting.

WHERE: SR 21 at Rice Mill Road/Market Boulevard in Port Wentworth in Chatham County.
