### **New Traffic Signal on State Route 38 at Maloney Drive in Hinesville – Today Flash Mode Next Tuesday Fully Operational**

**WHAT:** The Georgia Department of Transportation announces a new traffic signal began flashing today at the intersection of US 84/SR 38 at Maloney Drive in Hinesville. Message boards will be in place to prepare motorists for this new traffic signal. If weather permits, the signal will be fully operational Tuesday, August 4.

Motorists are reminded to pay special attention to traffic control devices, signs and posted speed limits to ensure safe passage through the new signal location.

**WHEN:** Flash mode: Thursday, July 30.  
Fully operational: Tuesday, August 4, weather permitting.

**WHERE:** US 84/SR 38 at Maloney Drive in Liberty County.
