Night work switch from Dyess Parkway to Deans Bridge changes

AUGUSTA- C and H Paving Inc. is about to balance two major resurfacing projects around the Augusta area to efficiently use asphalt resources.

As weather allows, the Georgia DOT contractor will **Monday from 6 p.m. to 6:30 a.m.** work to finalize the sub-grade and leveling portion of the one-mile resurfacing project on State Route (SR) 383/Jimmie Dyess Parkway before shifting crews over to begin the \$3.7 million SR 4/Deans Bridge Road resurfacing job from near Morgan Road to SR 10/Gordon Highway. This means after Monday night work is ending for the immediate future on Jimmie Dyess Parkway from Powell Road to the I-20 interchange. Contractors may return from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. during the week days to install curb and gutter sections with sidewalk and soon finalize mainline surface work and striping.

The traveling public can expect Deans Bridge Road lane closures for roadway milling and subgrade placement from Tuesday, September 13 to Thursday, September 15. Night work will only occur between 6 p.m. and 6:30 a.m.

C and H Paving Inc. will start the new resurfacing project at the Gordon Highway intersection with milling and surface treatment to level Deans Bridge Road toward Morgan Road.

When this work ends near Morgan Road, the crews will turn around in the opposite lanes to complete the same procedure back to Gordon Highway. General night work days are Sunday through Thursday unless weather alters the schedule.

Daytime restrictions on the Deans Bridge project are 6:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. Citizens will see daytime work such as ADA ramp construction and asphalt topping in the coming weeks as well.

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
