## ASPHALT REPAIR SCHEDULED ON STATE HIGHWAYS IN FIVE COUNTIES IN NORTHWEST GEORGIA

**WHEN:** Monday, July 9 through Friday, July 13, 2012 from 7:30 a.m. until 5:30 p.m.

**WHERE:** Carroll County: State Route (SR) 166  
Chattooga County: SR 1 and SR 100  
Dade County: SR 58  
Floyd County: SR 20, SR 113, SR 1 Loop and US 27  
Polk County: SR 6, and SR 113

**WHAT** Georgia DOT's maintenance crews will repair the deteriorating edges of pavement of SR 166 Carroll County; in Bartow County; SR 1 and SR 100 in Chattooga County; SR 58 in Dade County; SR 20, SR 1 Loop, SR 113 and US 27 in Floyd County; and SR 6 and SR 113 in Polk County. Work will proceed daily between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 5:30 p.m., weather permitting.

Each day, hundreds of Georgia Department of Transportation employees and contractors work on dozens of highway, bridge and intersection improvements throughout the state. Their work often brings them and heavy machinery in close proximity to travel lanes. Fifty-seven Georgia DOT personnel and many more motorists, passengers and contractors' workers have been killed in highway work zone accidents since 1973. Please help us prevent these tragedies by slowing down; being especially attentive and cautious as you pass through construction work zones; and always driving responsibly.
