Overnight Lane Closures Planned on I-285 for the *Transform 285/400* Improvement Project

What: Weather permitting, Georgia Department of Transportation contractors will close one right and left lane on I-285 eastbound for drainage cleaning and video.

When: Sunday, April 30 through Friday, May 5, nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. One left lane and one right lane will close alternately on I-285 eastbound from Riverside Drive to east of Ashford Dunwoody Road.

Advisory: Exact dates may change due to weather or other factors. Motorists are cautioned to reduce their speed while traveling through work zones, pay attention and watch for workers. Before heading out, get real-time information on work status and traffic conditions. Call 511, visit 511ga.org, or download the Georgia 511 app.
