Overnight Lane Closures Planned on I-285 for the *Transform 285/400* Improvement Project

What: Weather permitting, Georgia Department of Transportation contractors will close lanes on I-285 and on the Ashford Dunwoody Road on-ramp to I-285 eastbound. All closures are for drainage cleaning and video.

When: Sunday, May 7 through Friday, May 12, nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.: One left lane and one right lane will close alternately on I-285 eastbound from Riverside Drive to east of Ashford Dunwoody Road. No more than two miles will be closed at any time.

Sunday, May 7 through Friday, May 12, nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.: One right lane will close on I-285 westbound from east of Ashford Dunwoody to Riverside Drive. No more than two miles will be closed at any time.

Sunday, May 7 through Friday, May 12, nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.: One right lane and shoulder will close on the Ashford Dunwoody Road on-ramp to I-285 eastbound.

Advisory: Exact dates may change due to weather or other factors. Motorists are cautioned to reduce their speed while traveling through work zones, pay attention and watch for workers. Before heading out, get real-time information on work status and traffic conditions. Call 511, visit <u>511ga.org</u>, or download the Georgia 511 app.
