Overnight Lane Closures Planned on SR 400 for the Transform 285/400 Improvement Project

WHAT: Weather permitting, Georgia Department of Transportation construction partners will close lanes on SR 400 northbound and southbound for geotechnical investigations.

WHEN / WHERE:

Sunday, May 14, 8 p.m. through Monday, May 15, 6 a.m.: One left lane will close on 400 southbound at Abernathy Road.

Monday, May 15, 8 p.m. through Tuesday, May 16, 6 a.m. One right lane will close on SR 400 southbound from Hammond Drive to Johnson Ferry Road.

Wednesday, May 17, 8 p.m. through Thursday, May 18, 6 a.m. One right lane will close on SR 400 northbound from Johnson Ferry Road to Hammond Drive.

Advisory: <u>Exact dates may change due to weather or other factors</u>. Motorists are cautioned to reduce their speed while traveling through work zones, pay attention and watch for workers. Before heading out, get real-time information on work status and traffic conditions. Call 511, visit <u>511ga.org</u>, or download the Georgia 511 app.
