Overnight Lane Closures Planned on SR 400 for the Transform 285/400 Improvement Project

WHAT: Weather permitting, Georgia Department of Transportation construction partners will close lanes on SR 400 for geotechnical investigations, drainage cleaning and video, and subsurface utility investigations.

WHEN: Sunday, May 21 through Friday, May 26, nightly from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m.: One right lane and one left lane will close alternately on SR 400 northbound and southbound from the Glenridge Connector to Pitts Road.

Tuesday, May 23 through Thursday, May 25, nightly from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m.: One right lane and right shoulder on the Abernathy Road on-ramp to SR 400 northbound.

Advisory: Exact dates may change due to weather or other factors. Motorists are cautioned to reduce their speed while traveling through work zones, pay attention and watch for workers. Before heading out, get real-time information on work status and traffic conditions. Call 511, visit <u>511ga.org</u>, or download the Georgia 511 app.
