Overnight Ramp Closures from I-20 Eastbound to I-285 Will Require Detour

WHAT:

Weather permitting; Georgia Department of Transportation contractors will close the **I-20 eastbound** ramp to **I-285 northbound and southbound** from Friday night until Saturday morning. The closures will allow contractors to resurface the ramps. Motorists traveling on I-20 eastbound to I-285 northbound or southbound must use a detour during the ramp closure.

WHEN and WHERE:

The I-20 eastbound ramp to I-285 southbound will close from 9 p.m., Friday, August 12 until 2 a.m., Saturday

The I-20 eastbound ramp to I-285 northbound will close from 11 p.m., Friday, August 12 until 5 a.m., Saturday, August 13

DETOUR:

Motorists traveling on I-20 eastbound to I-285 northbound and southbound can take the exit to state Route 70/Fulton Industrial Boulevard; make a left on SR 70 Fulton Industrial Boulevard; make a right on SR 139/Martin Luther King Jr. Drive; continue on SR 139/Martin Luther King Jr. Drive to I-285 northbound or southbound.

ADVISORY:

Motorists are cautioned to reduce their speed while traveling through work zones, pay attention and watch for workers. Before heading out, get real-time information on work status and traffic conditions. Call 511, visit 511ga.org, or download the Georgia 511 app.
