## Halloween SEE & BE SEEN Street Event Monday, Oct. 31

ATLANTA—Halloween is here, and while we don't mean to cause a fright, this is pretty scary.

Pedestrian deaths are surging in Georgia - 206 people were killed while walking in 2015, up 18 percent from 2014. And this year deaths are up an average of 19 percent over 2015. With 37 percent more pedestrian fatalities in two years - that is cause for alarm.

There is no better time than Halloween to remind walkers and drivers of their shared responsibility for safety.

Georgia DOT's **SEE & BE SEEN** Halloween street event starts the conversation about ways to combat walker deaths. It is the responsibility of both groups to pay strict attention at all times; walkers ensuring they are always seen; and drivers slowing down so they will be able to stop before hitting a pedestrian.

WHAT: A Halloween happening kick-off for the SEE & BE SEEN pedestrian safety campaign to make it safer

to walk in Georgia.

**WHO:** Costumed Georgia Department of Transportation representatives will hit the street to engage

pedestrians, distribute information and suggest ways to be safer on foot.

**WHEN:** Halloween day – Monday, October 31 from 10 am to 1 pm.

WHERE: Midtown Atlanta at the corner of North Avenue and West Peachtree Street (by the North Avenue

MARTA station). See attached map

**NOTE:** Snapchat users: filters placed inside the app in locations around Georgia remind users to be safe –

especially during Halloween. Snapchat is a mobile app that changes its settings and appearances based

on location and time. It allows you to take temporary photos to share.
