## **RAILROAD CROSSING IMPROVEMENTS ON STATE ROUTE 40**

**WHEN:** 8 a.m. until 5 p.m., Tuesday, November 27 through Friday, November 30, weather permitting.

**WHERE:** Railroad Crossing on S.R. 40 between mile post 19 and mile post 20 in Camden County.

**WHAT:** At the request of CSX Transportation, the Georgia DOT announces a temporary lane closures on S.R. 40 at the railroad crossing between mile post 19 and mile post 20. The lane closures are scheduled between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Tuesday, November 27 through Friday, November 30, weather permitting. The lane closures will be utilized for railroad crossing slab replacement.

This is a WORK ZONE and extreme caution is necessary. Motorists are advised to reduce speeds as they travel through this work zone and expect delays in this area. Message signs, barrels and/or cones will be utilized to alert the public of the upcoming changes. Drivers should be aware that personnel and equipment will be operating in close proximity to travel lanes.

*Motorists can access real-time, statewide, route-specific information on accidents, road work, traffic and weather conditions through **Georgia 511** - a free phone service. By dialing 511, callers also can transfer to operators 24 hours a day to report incidents or request assistance. The system can be used to access transit providers, major airports, rideshare organizations, tourism information and 511 systems in surrounding states. Additionally, 511 is available online. Georgia DOT partners with sponsors for assistance in funding 511, thereby preserving tax dollars and helping sustain critical services.
