EXPECT DELAYS ON GREEN STREET FOR RESURFACING PROJECT IN AUGUSTA

Daily Lane Closures

WHAT: Daily, 7 a.m. until 5 p.m., Sunday, July 28 through Friday, August 2, weather permitting.

WHERE: S.R. 28/Green Street in both direction from 5th Street to John C. Calhoun Expressway.

WHAT: A contractor for Georgia DOT have scheduled to begin work on the State Route 28/Green Street for a resurfacing project beginning at 7:30 a.m. until 5 p.m., Sunday, July 28 through Friday, August 2, weather permitting. A single lane closure with will be utilized from Broad Street to John C. Calhoun Expressway.

The project will remove rough pavement on S.R.28/Green Street and replace it with a smoother driving surface. Crews will remove one and a half inch of asphalt and replace it with new asphalt, working in one lane at a time.

This is a **WORK ZONE** and extreme caution is necessary. Motorists are advised to reduce speeds as they travel through this work zone and expect delays in this area. Message signs, barrels and/or cones will be utilized to alert the public of the upcoming changes. Drivers should be aware that personnel and equipment will be operating in close proximity to travel lanes.

*Motorists can access real-time, statewide, route-specific information on accidents, road work, traffic and weather conditions through **Georgia 511** - a free phone service. By dialing 511, callers also can transfer to operators to 24 hours a day to report incidents or request assistance. The system can be used to access transit providers, major airports, rideshare organizations, tourism information and 511 systems in surrounding states. Additionally, 511 is available online. Georgia DOT partners with sponsors for assistance in funding 511, thereby*
