River Watch railroad crossing closure and detour starts tomorrow

WHAT: Concrete panel installation at the State Route (SR) 104/River Watch Parkway railroad crossing near Quarry Road will detour traffic for four days starting Tuesday, Feb. 16. This work will be completed in two stages with the first being this week on the westbound side heading toward Columbia County and the following week on the eastbound side.

The traveling public will detour using Stevens Creek Road and Claussen Road, while the CSX crossing undergoes the two-stage rehab. Posted signage will direct motorists during this time.

WHEN: Tuesday, Feb. 16 through Friday, Feb. 19 for westbound traffic and Tuesday, Feb. 23 through Friday, Feb. 26 for eastbound traffic, as weather allows; The detour will be removed once the first crossing work stage is finished and reposted when the final section begins the following week.
