

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River Watch Parkway extension traffic shift March 10



WHAT: Construction progress on the \$35 million River Watch Parkway Extension project calls for a minor traffic shift on Old Evans Road from Columbia Industrial Boulevard to Connor Drive starting Thursday morning at 8:30 a.m., weather permitting. This shift will move Columbia County traffic to the north side of Old Evans Road, allowing for further Stage 1 roadway construction by prime contractor E.R. Snell Contractor, Inc.

The traveling public should also be aware of daily lane closures the next few weeks for storm drain installation and grading along State Route 104/

Washington Road near Towne Center Drive. This coincides with the River Watch Parkway extension project as well.

Overall, this project will widen the existing Old Petersburg Road from Baston Road to Old Evans Road. From this point, construction follows Old Evans Road to Columbia Industrial Boulevard and then extends westward on new location tying into Washington Road at its intersection with Towne Center Drive. Citizens can expect construction of the new traffic signal here in the coming months.
