Road Closure Required for US 84/SR 38 Widening Project

WHAT: In conjunction with US84/SR38 widening project, contractors for the Georgia DOT have scheduled barricade placement on Monday, July 11 to close Richard James Road at US 84/SR 38 west of Argyle.

The closure of Richard James Road is necessary for the contractor to construct the new roadway alignment for the widening project. Barricades will be placed at SR 38 and north of the power transmission lines approximately .2 miles from SR 38. Residents on Richard James Road can assess SR 38 from Leland Smith Road. Richard James Road will have access to SR 38 once the new roadway is open to traffic.

WHEN: Closure starts Monday, July 11 remaining closed for the duration of the roadway construction.

WHERE: Richard James Road at US 84/SR 38 west of the City of Argyle in Clinch County.
