## **Rolling Lane Closures on SR 135 for New Striping, RPM Installation**

**What:** Weather permitting, Ozark Striping Co., a contractor for the Georgia Department of Transportation, will be installing new thermoplastic striping and/or raised pavement markers on state Route 135. **This is a slow-moving operation that requires rolling lane closures.**

Motorists are asked to use caution, reduce speed and remain alert to changing traffic conditions. If you approach a work crew please do not pass the work truck or trail/buffer vehicle, change lanes behind the truck or trail/buffer vehicle or swerve back and forth to see around the trucks.

Raised pavement markers and thermoplastic striping improve roadway visibility for drivers at night and in the rain.

**When:** Monday through Friday, March 16-20, from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. Ozark is scheduled to work in Atkinson County on Monday, March 16, and in Coffee County the remainder of the week.

**Where:** Atkinson County, from mileposts 0.0 to 9.0  
Coffee County, from mileposts 0.0 to 8.17
