SR 133 in Morven Closing Temporarily for Railroad Reconstruction

What: State Route 133 in Morven is scheduled to close temporarily for reconstruction of the railroad crossing, which will require a detour. The work is being done in preparation for the widening and reconstruction of SR 133 from Pauline Church Road to Old Quitman Adel Road. The \$28.2 million project was awarded in March and is scheduled to be complete in 2018. The road will be widened from two to four lanes with turn lanes as needed. SR 133 is in the Governors Road Improvement Program, a system of economic development highways.

When: Beginning at 8 a.m. Aug. 22, weather permitting. Reconstruction of the crossing is expected to be finished within five days.

Where: The railroad crossing on SR 133 between SR 76/First Street and Railroad Street in Morven. Northbound traffic will take SR 76 to Barney, turn left onto SR 122 and travel back to SR 133. Southbound traffic will take SR 122 to Barney, then SR 76 to Morven.
