Resurfacing Scheduled Monday on State Route (SR) 107 in Jeff Davis County

WHAT: Georgia DOT crews have scheduled temporary lane closure Monday from 9 a.m. until 5 p.m. to resurfacing a section on SR 107 in Jeff Davis County. Crews will remove rough pavement on SR 107 eastbound from mile markers 0 to mile marker 2 then replace it with new asphalt for a smoother driving surface.

This is a WORK ZONE and extreme caution is necessary. Motorists are advised to reduce speeds as they travel through this maintenance work zone. Directional signs, barrels and/or cones will be utilized to alert the public of the upcoming changes. Drivers should be aware that personnel and equipment will be operating in close proximity to travel lanes.

WHEN: 9 a.m. until 5 p.m., Monday, June 29, weather permitting.

WHERE: SR 107 eastbound from mile markers 0 to mile marker 2 in Jeff Davis County.
