SR 112 Detour Starts Jan. 19 for New Bridge Construction at Sapp Creek

What: State Route 112 at Sapp Creek will close for construction of a new bridge. The existing bridge was built in 1950 and does not meet current design standards and a recreational lake under construction by Grady County will overtop it. An off-site detour will be utilized to shorten construction time.

The contractor is Southern Concrete Construction Co. Inc. and the construction contract amount is \$2.7 million.

When: Beginning Tuesday, Jan. 19. The contractor is allowed to keep the road closed for 180 calendar days.

Where: SR 112 in Grady County. The project site is approximately five miles northwest of Cairo. The detour route during construction is SR 93 from Cairo to Pelham, then west along SR 65 to SR 112. This will add five miles to the normal travel distance for through traffic on SR 112.

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
