## **Railroad Crossing Closure On State Route 177 In Fargo**

**WHAT:** At the request of Norfolk Southern Corporation, the Georgia DOT announces a temporary road closure on S.R. 177 at Railroad Crossing in City of Fargo in Clinch County. This road closure is scheduled between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m., Thursday, January 21, weather permitting.

This railway maintenance operation and the road closures is a necessity to calibrate the railway creating a smooth transition for motorists and reduce continuous maintenance at this rail crossing. Motorists will be able to access businesses, schools, and residences in the area up to work zone.

**WHEN:** 9 a.m. until 3 p.m., Thursday, January 21, weather permitting.

**WHERE:** S.R. 177, City of Fargo in Clinch County.
