Lane Closures Suspended until next year

WHEN: Tuesday, November 20, 2012 continuing through Wednesday, January 2, 2013.

WHERE: S.R. 204/Abercorn Street in Chatham County.

WHAT: Contractors for Georgia DOT will not perform work that impedes traffic on S.R. 204/Abercorn Street in Chatham County starting Tuesday, November 20, 2012 continuing through Wednesday, January 2, 2013. Georgia DOT endeavors to work with the community and minimize traffic delays caused by the construction on S.R.204/Abercorn Street. In an effort to minimize the impact to the traveling public, no lane closures will be scheduled on S.R.204/Abercorn Street during the busy holiday shopping season.

Emergency maintenance work in the case of traffic accidents and other unpredictable types of transportation incidents could still cause lane closures and/or delays.
