Fall Line Freeway Bridge Beam Delivery Delaying Traffic

WHAT: On behalf of Sunbelt Structures, Inc., the Georgia Department of Transportation announces expected traffic delays on the Fall Line Freeway project **Thursday, June 25 from 9 a.m. until 3 p.m.** The area affected is State Route 24 mile marker 1.2 to 2 eastbound in Baldwin County. One lane will be closed during this time, as the contractor delivers and sets bridge beams at Town Creek.

Watch for a flagging and pilot car operation for up to six hours tomorrow. Sunbelt anticipates multiple traffic flow interruption intervals, as bridge beams are off-loaded at the site. Motorists should expect delays during this operation and should exercise caution by reducing speed within the work zone. Georgia DOT employees and contractors are just steps from danger working to complete this vital Fall Line Freeway project.

WHEN: Thursday, June 25 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., weather permitting

WHERE: Single eastbound lane closure SR 24 mile 1.2 to 2
