SR 24 Passing Lane Project Calls for Multiple Lane Closures

WHAT: The Georgia Department of Transportation wants the traveling public to be aware of lane closures planned **Wednesday, April 8** until **Friday, April 17** around the State Route 24/US 221 passing lane project in Jefferson County. Contractor C&H Paving will have closures in three lanes east and westbound from mile posts 12 to 14 for milling and inlay activities. All work is weather contingent. Motorist should expect delays during this operation and should exercise caution by reducing speed within the work zone.

Drivers should be aware that personnel and equipment will be operating in close proximity to travel lanes. Look for a pilot car and flagging operation.
