Georgia DOT Enhancing Roadway Nighttime Visibility for Motorists in Screven County

WHAT: Ozark Striping Company, a contractor for Georgia DOT, has scheduled roadway reflective pavement markers removal and replacement requiring rolling lane closures on SR 24 in Screven County between mile-post 7.4 to 30.5 this Thursday, July 16. All work is weather contingent.

Please be reminded reflective lane stripes improve roadway visibility helping drivers see the road at night and in the rain.

DO NOT pass the work truck or trail/buffer vehicle.

DO NOT swerve back and forth to see around the work truck or trail/buffer vehicle.

Motorists are asked to always use caution, reduce their speed and be alert to changing traffic conditions in all work zones.

WHERE: SR 24 between mile post 7.4 to 30.5 in Screven County.

WHEN: 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., Thursday, July 16, weather permitting.
