Patching Road This Week Gainesville

Gainesville, Ga. – Georgia DOT announces roadwork planned this week on SR 369/Brown’s Bridge Road from Academy Street to SR 60/John Morrow Parkway, if weather permits.

Please avoid this intersection today, extreme delays are expected. If weather cooperates, patching Highway 369 will be finished by Thursday evening.

WHAT: Crews will begin by removing damaged asphalt, replacing damaged asphalt then resurfacing the entire corridor it with new asphalt and a new, much smoother roadway. The outside westbound lane will be closed.

WHEN: Today, tomorrow and Thursday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

WHY: The pavement surface and structure is damaged and needs replacing.

WHERE: Crews are working westbound State Route 369/Browns Bridge Road from Academy Street west towards SR 60/John Morrow Parkway. Once westbound is finished to SR 60, crews will turn around and patch damaged eastbound lanes.
