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TRAFFIC SHIFT THURSDAY IN GAINESVILLE

Gainesville, Ga. – Georgia DOT announces E.R. Snell Contracting will shift traffic on SR 369/Brown’s Bridge Road at Cresswind Thursday, May 28, if weather permits. Please use extra caution as you travel through the work zone while traffic becomes familiar with the changes.

What: Cresswind is improving safety and access within their Community by building a tunnel to carry traffic under SR 369 connecting the Community that spreads on both sides of the highway.

Why: Traffic will be shifted to the south side of SR 369 to give room for a new bridge to be built that will allow Cresswind Parkway to be extended under SR 369/Browns Bridge Road. Georgia DOT approved the design through permit and is supervising the work because it affects State Route 369. This work is coordinated with the future widening of SR 369.

When: The traffic shift is planned for Thursday, May 28, 2015 if weather cooperates.

Where: State Route 369/Browns Bridge Road from Keith Bridge Road to Montgomery Drive.
