RoadWorks 2015 Program Continues; On Time, On Budget...

CONSTRUCTION SOON TO BEGIN ON AN INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENT PROJECT ON HIGHWAY 61 IN PAULDFING COUNTY

DALLAS, Ga. – Construction work could begin soon on an intersection improvement project on State Route (SR) 61 in Paulding County. Georgia DOT has just awarded a contract valued at nearly three million dollars for a construction project to improve the intersection of SR 61 and Nebo/Mayfield Road. The project consists of constructing a signalized intersection on SR 61/Villa Rica Highway at Mayfield Road/Nebo Road, with dedicated right turn lanes along SR 61 and dedicated left turn lanes along SR 61 and Mayfield Road/Nebo Road. The vertical and horizontal alignment will also be improved along SR 61 and Mayfield Road, the west side of the intersection.

This construction project is scheduled to be completed by the end of December 2016, at a construction cost of \$2,747,765. Information on construction and lane closure schedules on this project will be forthcoming before work begins.
