Striping Continues This Week on Multiple State Routes in SW Georgia

What: Weather permitting, Ozark Striping Co., a contractor for the Georgia Department of Transportation, will be installing new thermoplastic striping and/or raised pavement markers on multiple state routes. **This is a slow-moving operation that requires rolling lane closures.**

Motorists are asked to use caution, reduce speed and remain alert to changing traffic conditions. If you approach a work crew please do not pass the work truck or trail/buffer vehicle, change lanes behind the truck or trail/buffer vehicle or swerve back and forth to see around the trucks.

Raised pavement markers and thermoplastic striping improve roadway visibility for drivers at night and in the rain.
