Westbound traffic closed at I-20 Savannah River Bridge

What: A tractor-trailer tipped over early this morning on Interstate 20, damaging the westbound side of the Savannah River Bridge. Currently I-20 westbound traffic is closed in this area and being detoured via I-520. It could take another 4 to 5 hours to unload and move the tractor-trailer involved in the incident.

The Georgia Department of Transportation has a crew mobilized for railing repairs this morning and will begin as soon as possible. This area around mile 200 will shrink down to one lane during the corrective process, which could take up to three days weather permitting.

There are currently no changes to the contracted slab repair work scheduled on the eastbound side of I-20 in the same vicinity. The public should expect delays and slow down when traveling near the South Carolina line this week.

When: Tuesday, Feb. 9 through possibly Thursday, Feb. 11 until the location is fixed; Traffic is closed until possibly noon due to ongoing vehicle removal. The single lane should be open after that.

Where: I-20 bridge westbound around mile post 200 over the Savannah River; Be cautious in this work zone.
