Richmond and Columbia County TIA projects affecting traffic starting Monday

What: Two Transportation Investment Act (TIA) funded projects will affect Richmond and Columbia County travelers this week through early June. The improvements at the intersection of Deans Bridge Road and Gordon Highway and the widening of Robinson Avenue in Grovetown all have construction activities impacting motorists as weather allows. Be aware of posted speed limits and workers and heavy equipment moving close to the travel lanes.

Robinson Avenue (Columbia):

This TIA funded project begins major construction on Monday, May 2. The 1.8-mile widening of State Route (SR) 223/Robinson Avenue in the city of Grovetown spans from Wrightsboro Road to Gordon Highway. Two lanes will shrink to one at various times between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. Monday through Saturday through Friday, June 3. The traveling public will notice sidewalk demolition and grading.

Deans Bridge Road @ Gordon Highway (Richmond):

Starting Monday as well, contractors will be working around the intersection's various right turn lanes. Traffic interruption is set between 7 a.m. and 4 p.m. Look for demo and grading at this intersection improvement and signal upgrade project throughout the next month Mondays through Saturdays.
