EXPECT DELAYS: Traffic Signal Outage Today at State Route 204/Abercorn Street and Rio Road

WHAT: Contractors for Georgia DOT will be modifying the traffic signal at the intersection of S.R. 204/Abercorn Street and Rio Road in Chatham County. The traffic signal outage is scheduled today starting from 9:30 a.m. and could last until 2 p.m. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes.

This temporary traffic signal outage is necessary for the contractor to upgrade traffic signals at this intersection in conjunction with the widening project on SR 204. Police will be utilized to direct traffic through the work zone and motorists should expect delays.

This is a **WORK ZONE** and extreme caution is necessary. Motorists are advised to reduce speeds as they travel through this construction work zone. Message signs, barrels and/or cones will be utilized to alert the public of the upcoming changes. Drivers should be aware that personnel and equipment will be operating in close proximity to travel lanes.

WHEN: Beginning 9:30 a.m., Tuesday, June 9 until 2 p.m., weather permitting.

WHERE: S.R. 204/Abercorn Street and Rio Road intersection in Chatham County.
