## **US 441 Madison Bypass to Watkinsville Bypass Open Houses**

MADISON - The Georgia Department of Transportation is hosting two upcoming Public Information Open House (PIOH) events discussing possible US 441 improvements from the Madison Bypass to the Watkinsville Bypass.

Department representatives will attend these meetings to discuss the project findings to date, establish local priorities and identify potential resources in the corridor affecting both Morgan and Oconee County. This information will be essential in the design of the project, as alignments have not yet been developed.

- **5 p.m. to 7 p.m., November 1, Morgan County High School Cafeteria, 1231 College Drive, Madison**

The PIOH's will be informal with no official presentation. Citizens may enter both sites at any point during the two-hour timeframe.
