## **NIGHTTIME RESURFACING PROJECT LESSENS IMPACT TO COMMUTERS IN JESUP**

Jesup, GA – The Georgia Department of Transportation announces resurfacing on US 84/SR 38. Crews have begun resurfacing the roadway through the City of Jesup.

Resurfacing began Monday, September 30 and continues for approximately 90 days. Crews will work nightly in an effort to minimize the impact to the traveling public. Weeknight work hours are 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., if weather permits. Minor delays are expected on S.R. 38 between Sunset Boulevard and the merge with US 301. Traffic will be shifted in both directions while lanes are milled and inlayed with new asphalt.

This 3 mile long resurfacing of S.R. 38 from Sunset Boulevard to US 301 is under contract for \$4.4 million. The contract completion date is March 31, 2014.

*Each day, hundreds of Georgia Department of Transportation employees and contractors work on dozens of highway, bridge and intersection improvements throughout the state. Their work often brings them and heavy machinery in close proximity to travel lanes. Fifty-seven Georgia DOT personnel and many more motorists, passengers and contractors' workers have been killed in highway work zone accidents since 1973.
