Metro Road Work...

Construction & Lane Closures Weekend Schedule

ATLANTA-Georgia Department of Transportation projects to improve highway infrastructure throughout Metropolitan Atlanta continue this weekend, weather permitting. Construction on the I-75 Express Lanes and I-20 will require lane closures, which, in turn, are likely to result in delays. Motorists are advised to exercise caution by reducing speed while driving through work zones.

The Georgia DOT encourages motorists to call 511, visit 511ga.org, or check the *511 Georgia and Atlanta Traffic* app before departing for real-time information on work status and traffic conditions.

Planned work this weekend is as follows:

Northwest Corridor Express Lanes

- **On I-575, one southbound lane will close between Barrett Parkway and the I-75 interchange from 8 p.m., Friday until 5 a.m., Monday.**
- **On I-575, one northbound lane will close between SR 92/ Alabama Road and Towne Lake Parkway from 9 p.m., Friday until 5 a.m., Monday.**
- **On I-575, one northbound lane will close between Barrett Parkway and Chastain Road from 9 p.m., Friday until 5 a.m., Saturday. A traffic pace will also take place between Barrett Parkway and Chastain road from 10 p.m., Friday until 2 a.m., Saturday. The traffic pace will require motorists to drive 5 mph -10 mph to allow contractors to work across the interstate lanes.**

South Metro Express Lanes

- **On I-75, two northbound lanes will close between Hudson Bridge Road and Mt. Zion Boulevard from 9 p.m., Friday until 5 a.m., Saturday for sign structure work.**

- **On I-75, one southbound lane will close between Mt. Zion Boulevard and SR 138/Lake Spivey Parkway from 9 p.m., Friday until 7 a.m., Saturday for sign structure work.**

I-75

- **Two southbound lanes will close between SR 120 Loop/ South Marietta Parkway and SR 280/Delk Road from 8 p.m., Sunday until 5 a.m., Monday.**

I-20

- **Two westbound lanes and the shoulder will close between Hill Street and the I-285 interchange continuously from 9 p.m., Friday until 5 a.m., Monday.**
- **Two eastbound lanes and the shoulder will close between SR 70/Fulton Industrial Boulevard and SR 139/Martin Luther King Jr. Drive continuously from 9 p.m., Friday until 5 a.m., Monday.**
- **One eastbound and one westbound lane and the shoulders will close between SR 70/Fulton Industrial Boulevard and the I-285 interchange from 7 a.m., until 7 p.m., Saturday and Sunday.**
- **One lane will close on SR 139/Martin Luther King Jr. Drive underneath I-20 from 9 p.m., Friday until 5 a.m., Monday.**
- **One lane will close on Langhorn Street underneath I-20 from 9 p.m., Friday until 5 a.m., Monday.**

I-285

- **Two southbound lanes will close between Washington Road and Atlanta Road from 9 p.m., Sunday until 5 a.m., Monday.**
- **Two northbound and two southbound lanes will close at Atlanta Road from 9 p.m., Friday until 9 p.m., Saturday.**
- **One southbound lane will close at SR 155/Flat Shoals Parkway from 9 p.m., Sunday until 5 a.m., Monday.**

Georgia (State Route) 400

- **Two northbound and two southbound lanes will close just before and after Encore Parkway from 5 a.m., until 9 p.m., Saturday.**

Other State Routes

- **One lane will close on SR 141 Connector/Lenox Road Connector between Phipps Boulevard and Peachtree Road from 7 a.m., until 11 a.m., Sunday.**
- **On SR 92/Woodstock Road, one lane will close between the Cobb County line and SR 9/ Alpharetta Highway from 9 p.m., Friday until 5 a.m., Saturday and from 9 p.m., Sunday until 5 a.m., Monday.**

Other Georgia DOT work and routine maintenance will necessitate various lane closures this weekend (as detailed in the attached spreadsheets); the Department also cautions that incident and emergency repair related closures may be necessary on any route at any time. As always, drive cautiously, courteously, undistracted and unimpaired.
