## **CONSTRUCTION WORK RESUMES THIS WEEKEND AFTER EASTER, SPRING BREAK, FINAL FOUR HIATUS**

ATLANTA –Georgia Department of Transportation projects will be back in full swing this weekend across metro Atlanta after taking a couple of weekends off to accommodate traffic related to Easter, Spring Break and the NCAA Basketball Tournament. Lane closures on interstates and state routes will be in place all weekend, weather permitting.

First, contractors are planning to close up to three lanes in each direction across top end of I-285 between Ashford-Dunwoody Road and Paces Ferry Road. Motorists need to plan ahead and seek alternate routes around the work area.

“I-285 across the top end is the place to avoid this weekend,” said GDOT District Construction Engineer Shun Pringle. “Long delays are expected all weekend.”

Also, contractors will continue the construction of the bridges in the SR 400/I-85 interchange. Flagging operations on surface streets around the interchange and various lane closures on State Route 400 are expected to cause delays in the area so motorists should plan ahead to avoid the backups. The HOV ramps at I-85 and Lindbergh Drive also remain closed until mid-July for work on the bridge columns for the interchange.
