Weeknight and Weekend Ramp Closure at I-285 and Hollowell Parkway

WHAT:

Weather permitting; Georgia Department of Transportation contractors will close the I-285 northbound off-ramp to US 278/US 78/SR8/Hollowell Parkway and one northbound lane on I-285 between the I-20 interchange and Bolton Road. The closure will take place nightly during the weekdays and continually over the weekend. The closure will allow contractors to perform concrete rehabilitation, which in turn will create a smoother ride for motorists.

WHEN:

9 p.m., Wednesday, August 17 until 5 a.m., Thursday, August 18
9 p.m., Thursday, August 18 until 5 a.m., Friday, August 19
Continuously from 9 p.m., Friday, August 19 until 5 a.m., Monday August 22

WHERE:

I-285 northbound off-ramp to US 278/US 78/SR8/Hollowell Parkway
One northbound lane on I-285 between the I-20 interchange and Bolton Road

DETOUR:

Motorists traveling on I-285 northbound to US 278/US 78/SR 8/Hollowell Parkway can take I-20 westbound to SR 70/Fulton Industrial Boulevard; make a right on SR 70/Fulton Industrial Boulevard; continue on SR 70/ Fulton Industrial Boulevard to US 278/US 78/ SR 8/ Hollowell Parkway.
