Windsor Spring Road Lane Closures Scheduled At Willis Foreman Road

WHAT: The Georgia Department of Transportation on behalf of E.R. Snell Contractor, Inc. wants motorists to be aware of scheduled Windsor Spring Road construction project lane closures in the intersection area of Willis Foreman Road starting **Tuesday, June 16** and lasting through early next week. Contractors will be installing power, gas and water lines. All work is weather contingent. Motorist should expect delays during this operation and should exercise caution by reducing speed within the work zone.

The Phase 4 Windsor Spring project begins south of the intersection of Windsor Spring Road and Willis Foreman Road and terminates at the intersection of Tobacco Road. This project is approximately 3.3 miles long and is scheduled for completion April 30, 2017.

The existing two-lane, 6-foot graded shoulder Urban Minor Arterial facility will be widened to four, 11-foot wide lanes (two lanes in each direction) separated by a raised median. The contract includes construction of 16-foot shoulders with curb and gutter and an 8-foot wide multi-use trail on both sides of the roadway. This \$30 million Windsor Springs Road widening phase is partially funded by the Transportation Investment Act (TIA).
