Lane closure between Laurel Oak Drive and Turkey Trail Drive starts tomorrow

WHAT: Construction progress on the Windsor Spring Road Phase 4 widening project requires a lane closure between Laurel Oak Drive and Turkey Trail Drive starting tomorrow and running through Friday. Contractors will install a new eight-inch water main as weather allows.

GDOT is committed to providing the highest level of safety for both motorists and workers. Motorists should understand that four-out-of-five victims in work zone crashes are actually drivers and passengers. We ask all drivers to pay attention, slow down and watch for contract workers.

This work is part of the Phase 4 project beginning south of the intersection of Windsor Spring Road and Willis Foreman Road and terminating at the intersection of Tobacco Road. This project is approximately 3.3 miles long and scheduled for completion April 30, 2017. The \$30 million Windsor Spring Road widening phase is partially funded by the Transportation Investment Act (TIA).

WHEN: Wednesday, April 27 through Friday, April 29 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

WHERE: Windsor Spring Road between Laurel Oak Drive and Turkey Trail Drive (Richmond County)
