Windsor Spring Road widening closing northbound lane near Hephzibah

WHAT: Continued Windsor Spring Road Construction by E.R. Snell Contractor, Inc. is closing the northbound right lane from the Hephzibah city limit (one-half mile south of Willis Foreman Road) to Turkey Trail Drive.

E.R. Snell will install the closure from **9 a.m. to 3 p.m.** for temporary widening construction activities starting today through **Friday, October 23**. All work is weather contingent. Motorist should expect delays during this operation and should exercise caution by reducing speed within the work zone.

The Phase 4 Windsor Spring project begins south of the intersection of Windsor Spring Road and Willis Foreman Road and terminates at the intersection of Tobacco Road. This project is approximately 3.3 miles long and is scheduled for completion April 30, 2017.

WHEN: Monday, October 19 through Friday, October 23 from 9 a.m. until 3 p.m., weather permitting

WHERE: Hephzibah city limit to Turkey Trail Drive in the northbound right lane
