Wrightsboro Road night work to cause slight delay

WHAT: Construction related utility relocation inside the city of Grovetown will reduce lanes at the Wrightsboro Road and Horizon Parkway intersection starting tonight. Law enforcement will control intersection movement during nightly work hours this week. The roadway will remain open but the traveling public should expect a small delay.

Whenever you approach a work zone: slow down; allow extra distance between vehicles; read signs; obey road crew flaggers; and expect the unexpected.

WHEN: Nightly from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. starting today and finishing Friday, Aug. 19 weather permitting

WHERE: Intersection of Wrightsboro Road and Horizon Parkway in the city of Grovetown

WHY: The closure allows AT&T contractors to install new communications conduit as part of construction related utility relocations on the \$2.06 million Transportation Investment Act (TIA) funded Wrightsboro Road improvement project. Overall, this TIA project runs from Horizon Parkway to the Robinson Avenue intersection.
