Wrightsboro Road Lane Closures Expected

WHAT: On behalf of Reeves Construction, the Georgia Department of Transportation announces multiple planned lane closures on the Wrightsboro Road Widening and Reconstruction Project beginning **Monday, June 1** lasting through **Saturday, June 6**. At various times, one-of-two outside westbound or eastbound lanes on Wrightsboro Road from the Bobby Jones Expressway (Interstate 520) ramp to Barton Chapel Road will be closed. Asphalt paving base will also be applied throughout the project from **Tuesday, June 2** through **Friday, June 5** on Augusta West Parkway, Old Wrightsboro Road and Maddox Drive.

WHEN: 8:30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m., Monday, June 1 until Saturday, June 6 weather permitting for the expected lane closures

WHERE: The Wrightsboro Road project between the I-520 ramp and Barton Chapel Road in Richmond County

This is a **WORK ZONE** and extreme caution is necessary. Motorists are advised to reduce speeds as they travel through this and all work zones. Message signs, barrels and/or cones will be utilized to alert the public of the upcoming changes. Drivers should be aware that personnel and equipment will be operating in close proximity to travel lanes.
